CRAFT #1

- PAPER PLATE
- STAPLER
- PIPE CLEANER
- TAPE
- RULER
- PENCIL

CRAFT #2

- A PAPER ENVELOPE
- MARKERS
- PIPE CLEANER
- CRAYONS/COLORED PENCILS
- TAPE






DIRECTIONS FOR "BOOK-TIVITY"

CRAFT #1


1. Turn to the back of the paper plate and in the center of the plate, trace a 3 in x 3 in square using a ruler.

Crafting Tip: You may need to adjust measurements depending on the size of plate you are using.



2. Using a ruler, lightly draw a line from one corner of the square to the edge of the plate. Rotate your plate and repeat this step for the remaining three corners of the square (see picture on the left for reference). Once you've drawn all 4 lines, cut the lines from the edge to the start of the square. Be careful not to cut into the square that is outlined.

3. Next, fold each flap toward the center of the plate. Crease each fold tightly. As you begin to fold, a triangle flap will form on the sides. Take the triangle flap and fold them up, tucking them in and stapling them to the inside of the basket as you go.



4. Last, take one pipe cleaner and tape each end to the opposite sides of the basket to create a handle.

Crafty tip: You can use yarn or ribbon in place of a pipe cleaner.




DIRECTIONS FOR "BOOK-TIVITY"

CRAFT #2



1. Take one envelope and tuck the top flap inside the opening.

2. Take one pipe cleaner to tape each end on opposite sides of the basket to create a handle.



3. Use crayons, markers, or color pencils to decorate your envelope basket to your liking. Don't forget to add eyes, nose, and a mouth for some added fun!
